# Rolling Hills Heifer Program

## Guidelines

- **Must be in 7<sup>th</sup> grade or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.**
- **Recipient can be male or female.**
- **3 personal recommendation letters are required.**  
Example-Teacher, Veterinarian, Club Leader.
- **Recipient must be interested in agriculture and willing to accept total responsibility for the daily care of the heifers.**
- **Recipient must be willing to promote the Rolling Hills Heifer Program.**
- **The recipient must maintain accurate records of income and expenditures during the five years; the recipient will be asked to submit these records plus a brief summary of activities annually.**
- **At the end of five years, the recipient is to pay back the *Rolling Hills Heifer Program* in cash the equivalent value of 5 heifers so more can be purchased for next year's recipients.**
